ORDINANCE NO. 03-04

THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF NEW MARKET

SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FROM SIDEWALKS

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of New Market have determined to enact this Ordinance for the purpose of promoting pedestrian safety in the Town;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF NEW MARKET AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Snow Removal. Every owner, tenant or occupant of a building, property or lot abutting on a public sidewalk shall remove and clear all snow and ice from the surface of the sidewalk for a minimum width of two feet, within six hours from the end of the snowfall or other precipitation, or if the snowfall or other precipitation occurred overnight, by 2:00 P.M. the following afternoon. If ice is not readily removable, sufficient calcium chloride or similar commercially available product shall be applied to effectively melt and remove the accumulation of ice.

SECTION 2. <u>Municipal Infraction</u>. A violation of this ordinance shall be a municipal infraction. Each day a violation occurs or continues is deemed a separate offense. The penalty for violation shall be One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall become effective on the $\frac{3.2}{4}$ day of $\frac{1}{4}$ breaky, 200 $\frac{4}{4}$.
