**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAND
DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NEW MARKET**

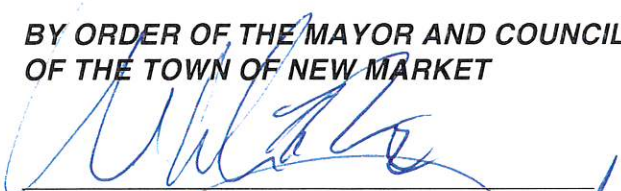
WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of New Market have determined to amend the Land Development Ordinance of the Town of New Market (the "Ordinance");

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordained by the Mayor and Council of New Market the Land Development Ordinance, Article IV. District Regulations, Section 1.11 Accessory Uses is hereby amended, by revising the following provision:

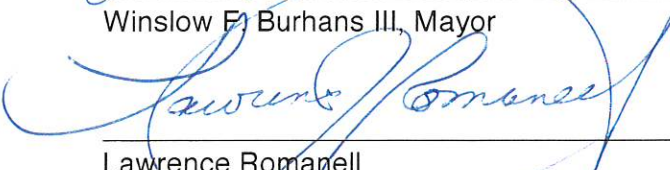
1.11.12 Poultry as Pets and Beekeeping. Up to ~~four~~ *twelve* domestic fowl are allowed per single-family dwelling. No roosters and no slaughtering are allowed. Poultry shall be kept within a secure enclosure and not allowed to run free. Enclosures for poultry or bees shall be located not closer than 25' to the nearest neighbor's residence.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date of passage.

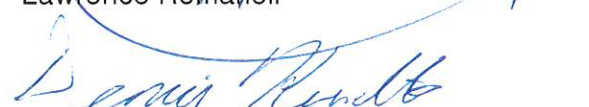

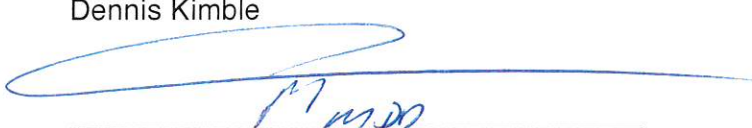
